About MMTTC

Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MMTTC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi under UGC, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India (formerly Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme) was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chairman of **UGC** Prof. M. Jagdesh Kumar. The vision of this centre is to develop skills & competencies in the higher education faculty members for better teaching, learning and research in line with NEP 2020. This Centre as TLC has successfully organized 64 programmes. This Centre has also conducted 03 Annual Refresher Programme In Teaching (ARPIT) courses through SWAYAM in Sanskrit discipline and has published 02 handbooks for teaching Sanskrit. Our MMTTC since its inception in September 2023 has successfully organized 45 programmes viz. 08 One Week Faculty Development Programme (07 in online and 01 in offline mode), 02 One Month Mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (online mode), 06 Two Weeks Refresher Course (online mode) and 29 Eight Days NEP Orientation & Sensitization programmes till now.

About H.R.P.G. College

Hiralal RamNiwas Post Graduate College—a premier institution of Eastern Uttar Pradesh affiliated with Siddhartha University, Kapilvastu, Siddharth Nagar—was established in 1966 by Late Shri Kudilal Ji Rungta and Shri Ram Kripal Ji Rungta in memory of their fathers, Late Shri Hiralal Ji Rungta and Late Shri Ram Niwas Ji Rungta. Founded to promote higher education in rural Eastern UP, the college is managed by the Hiralal RamNiwas Educational Society, registered with the Registrar of Societies.

Backdrop

As we all know that the capacity building of faculty across all levels of Higher Education is one of the thrust areas of quality & excellence in education which is well catered through training programmes conducted by HRDC's of UGCs & various Centres under PMMMNMTT scheme. In keeping view the optimal utilization of infrastructure, human & financial resources, the Ministry of Education (MOE) has sought that synergy & integration between these two Centres should be strengthened and the entire capacity building effort to be renamed & popularized as Malaviya Mission through Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Programme (MMTTP) which was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister of Education Sh. Dharmendra Pradhan on 5th September 2023. To implement this programme, 111 institutions (66 HRDCs & 45 PMMMNMTTs) were identified as Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centres. Each Centre has to conduct 36 Programmes per year which can be classified into 4 types of programmes viz. 24-NEP Orientation & Sensitization, 2-FIPs, 5-Short-Term Programmes, & 5-Refresher Programmes. In this backdrop, this 08 days online national NEP Orientation & Sensitization Programme is being organized with an intent to orient & sensitize Higher Education faculty on the 10 key themes of NEP-2020 viz. Holistic and Multidisciplinary Education; Indian Knowledge Systems; Academic Leadership, Governance, and Management; Higher Education and Society; Research and Development; Skill Development; Student Diversity & Inclusive Education; Autonomy to the institution & choice to the students; Curriculum, Development, Pedagogy & Assessment and Information & Communication Technology.
