🕕 About

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of Ministry of Education, Government of India. This scheme was launched with an intent to improve quality in educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the centre is to develop skills and competencies of teachers and teacher educators associated with language education especially Sanskrit for designing, developing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems. The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) for newly inducted higher education faculty and also notified as National Resource Centre (NRC) for developing online Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT-2018, 2019 & 2020 courses) through SWAYAM in the discipline Sanskrit by Department of Higher Education of Ministry of Education, GOI. In addition to this, the centre has published two handbooks for teaching Sanskrit one at upper primary level and other at secondary level. The centre has successfully organized 34 programmes and 03 Faculty Induction Programme till Phase-IV and has benefitted 2023 participants through these programmes. All the programmes in phase-V will be conducted under patronship of hon'ble Vice Chancellor.

Backdrop

The global prevailing educational world is grappling with online teaching and learning amid corona virus outbreak. In this mode of teaching teachers usually share learning materials and communicate with their students either in synchronous or asynchronous ways. Video emerges as one of the powerful e-resource for student engagement in this context especially by providing ample opportunities to apply acquired knowledge & skills, to revise content and to give reinforcement. Apart from this, videos have a special importance when developed on curriculum specific content as per the learning need, level and style of the students. They facilitate remote learning opportunities as they can be accessed anytime and from anywhere. In addition to this, they have tremendous potential not only to bridge the gap created between the offline and online mode of teaching and learning but also to enhance the quality of online teaching and learning. Thus, there is a pressing need to have competencies for developing and editing videos by using various softwares and tools. In this backdrop three days national workshop has been organized especially for the teachers with an intent to enhance their video developing and editing skills through use of various tools and softwares.



The objectives of this workshop are:

- to acquaint with various video developing and editing tools & softwares.
- to give insight in the process and various ways of developing and editing videos.
- to enhance skills & competencies related to video development and editing.

Target Group

- Higher Education faculty of all disciplines but preference to language and traditional disciplines such as Vyakaran, Vastushastra, Darshan, Sahitya, Dharamshastra, Jyotisha etc.
- Teacher Educators from both traditional and modern universities.
- Sanskrit school teachers only PGT or TGT.
