### About

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of Ministry of Education, Government of India. This scheme was launched with an intent to improve quality in educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the centre is to develop skills and competencies of teachers and teacher educators associated with language education especially Sanskrit for designing, developing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems. The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) for newly inducted higher education faculty and also notified as National Resource Centre (NRC) for developing online Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPIT-2018, 2019 & 2020 courses) through SWAYAM in the discipline Sanskrit by Department of Higher Education of Ministry of Education, GOI. In addition to this, the centre has published two handbooks for teaching Sanskrit one at upper primary level and other at secondary level. The centre has successfully organized 40 programmes and 03 Faculty Induction Programmes (FIP) till now. All the programmes in phase-V are conducted under patronship of hon'ble Vice Chancellor.

# Backdrop

We all know that educational research plays a vital role in the overall development of education system by aiming at knowledge advancement & improving practices. It follows a well-defined & systematic scientific process to collect & analyse data for problem solving which requires multiple research skills.
