Phase IV, Programme No. - 11 05 Days Online National Workshop on Educational Management and Leadership in Sanskrit Vangmaya From 15th to 19th March, 2021

Brief Report

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized 05 Days Online National Workshop on Educational Management and Leadership in Sanskrit Vangmaya from 15th to 19th March, 2021 which is 11th programme of its IVth phase. The objectives of this workshop were to acquaint the participants with the basic concepts of Educational Management and Leadership and to develop conceptual understanding of these concepts in Sanskrit Vangmaya with their educational implications and relevance to present education system. This online workshop was conducted through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Project Head Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj followed by Chief guest address of Prof. Roop Kishore Shastri (Vice Chancellor, Gurukul Kangri University, Haridwar, Uttarakhand) and presidential address of hon'ble Vice Chancellor of our University Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey with vote of thanks by Prof. K. Bharathbooshan (Dean & Head, Faculty of Education). The workshop was transacted through 30 distinctly designed sessions comprising of Inaugural, Induction, 14 Technical, 05 Q&A sessions, 05 Self-practice, Online assessment, Feedback, Sharing of experiences and Valedictory sessions. The registration received till last date were 139 out of which 120 participants were given confirmation after screening, out of which only 98 continued & 22 left due to their personal reasons. In 98 participants, 76 were from 17 states and 22 from 02 UTs. The 17 states and number of participants were Andhra Pradesh (05), Assam (01), Bihar (06), Gujarat (03), Haryana (07), Jharkhand (02), Karnataka (02), Kerala (01), Maharashtra (10), Odisha (02), Rajasthan (09), Tamil Nadu (03), Telangana (02), Tripura (02), Uttar Pradesh (13), Uttarakhand (06) & West Bengal (02) and two UTs were Chandigarh (01) and Delhi (21). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of eight Resource **Persons** having expertise in the concerned area from various reputed institutions. The main themes covered in the workshop were - Educational Management, Leadership Skills, Academic & Situational Leadership, Effective Management & Leadership Styles, Leaders for Creating Conducive Learning Culture, Educational Leadership in Sanskrit Vangmaya, Management in Vidura Neeti, Kautilya Shastra, Shrimad Bhagwat Geeta, Valmiki Ramayana Sutra & Vedic Sahitya and Management & Leadership in Upanishads. The participants were assigned **10 assignments** on the basis of the themes taken up in the technical sessions. An online assessment test was administered where 54% of the participants scored above 60%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view an online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 74%, 23%, 02% & 01% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the workshop was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 79% in Excellent, 17% in Very good, 03% in Good, 01% in Satisfactory and Nil in Unsatisfactory category. In the valedictory session, the Project **Head** welcomed the guests and presented the workshop report followed by **Chief guest** address by **Prof. V. Muralidhara Sharma** (Vice Chancellor, National Sanskrit University, Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh) and presidential address by our hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey. The workshop ended with vote of thanks by Dean & Head, Faculty of Education and shanti paath. After the completion of the workshop, the e-certificates and e-photo album were mailed to the successful participants.
