## Phase IV, Programme No. - 03 03 Days Online National Workshop on Design & Develop: Online Assessment

From 08<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2020

## **Brief Report**

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University, (Central University) New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (MHRD), Govt. of India organized 03 Days Online National Workshop (3<sup>rd</sup> programme of its IV<sup>th</sup> phase) on Design & Develop: Online Assessment from 08<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2020. The objectives of this workshop were to familiarize the participants with various online assessment tools, softwares & Apps and develop competencies to design, develop and deliver online assessment. The online workshop was conducted through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note about the workshop by the Project Head Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj followed by Chief guest address by Shri. Mukul Kanitkar (National Organizing Secretary, Bhartiya Shikshan Mandal, New Delhi) and inaugural address of hon'ble Vice Chancellor of our University Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey. The workshop was transacted through 18 distinctly designed sessions comprising of Inaugural, Induction, 08 Technical sessions, 03 Question & Answer sessions, 03 Self-practice, Online assessment, Feedback, Sharing of experiences by the Participants and Valedictory session. The registration received till last date was 507 out of which 329 participants were screened and given confirmation in phase manner. Although, 249 participants confirmed their participation but only 228 continued & 21 left due to their personal reasons. In 228 participants, 227 were from 21 states and 2 UTs of India and one from outside India viz. Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The participants from 21 states include Andhra Pradesh (12), Assam (04), Bihar (03), Gujarat (04), Haryana (18), Himachal Pradesh (02), Jharkhand (01), Karnataka (05), Kerala (03), Madhya Pradesh (02), Maharashtra (12), Meghalaya (01), Odisha (05), Punjab (01), Rajasthan (22), Tamil Nadu (14), Telangana (01), Tripura (07), Uttarakhand (09), Uttar Pradesh (37) & West Bengal (09) while that of two UTs were Chandigarh (04) and Delhi (50). All the technical sessions designed on demonstrative approach were conducted under the able guidance of five Resource Persons having the expertise in this area from various reputed institutions. The main themes covered in the workshop were - Online Assessment: Overall view and Assessment Tools for Short & Long Answer Questions, Online Assessment & Discussion Forms, Online Attendance & Certificates, Hot Potatoes and Google Forms. On the basis of demonstrative sessions, the participants were given 07 assignments by the Resource Persons. In online administered assessment test 64% of the participants scored above 60%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view, an online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 78%, 20%, 02% & Nil in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the workshop was also taken on 10 points in five categories viz. Excellent, Very good, Good, Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory. The average percentage on all 10 points in five categories was found to be 75% in Excellent, 20% in Very good, 04% Good, 01% Satisfactory and Nil in Unsatisfactory. In the valedictory session, the Project Head welcomed the guests and presented the workshop report followed by the Chief guest address by Vice Chairman, UGC Dr. Bhushan Patwardhan and Presidential address by Vice Chancellor of our University Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey. The workshop ended with vote of thanks. After the completion of the workshop, the e-certificates and e-photo album were mailed to the successful participants
