## Phase-V, Programme-10 Two Weeks Online National Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Professional Skill Development of Teachers From 14<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> December, 2021

## **Brief Report**

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized Two Weeks Online National Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Professional Skill Development of Teachers from 14th to 23rd December, 2021 which is the 10<sup>th</sup> programme of Phase-V. The objectives of this programme were to give insight in enhancing various pedagogical skills, research skills & assessment skills and to promote technological skills associated with teaching, assessment, econtent development & Learning Management Systems. This programme was conducted in an online mode through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj followed by the Presidential Address of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of our University, Prof. Murlimanohar Pathak. The registrations received for the programme were 45 and the same continued the programme successfully. Out of 45 participants, 30 were from 10 states and 15 from 02 UTs of our country. The participants from 12 states include Andhra Pradesh (03), Bihar (03), Himachal Pradesh (01), Odisha (02), Rajasthan (04), Tamil Nadu (01), Telangana (01) Uttarakhand (06), Uttar Pradesh (08) & West Bengal (01) while that of 02 UT was Delhi (14) & Jammu Kashmir (01). The programme was transacted through 54 distinctly designed sessions comprising of inaugural, induction, 29 demonstrations based technical sessions, 10 Question & Answer sessions and 10 self-practice sessions, 01 each viz. online assessment, feedback, sharing of experiences and valedictory sessions. All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of 27 Resource Persons (Table-III) having expertise in the concerned area from various reputed institutions of the Country. The main themes covered in this FDP were - Skills of Introduction & Conclusion, Questioning & Reinforcement, Stimulus Variation & Illustration, Strategies for Experiential Learning, Cooperative Learning, Blended learning & Developing Leadership Skills, Writing of Learning Objectives, Soft Skills, Communication Skills, Developing Multiple Choice Questions, Socrative & Kahoot as formative assessment tools, e-Content Development, Edmodo & Google Classroom as LMS, Development of MOOCS, Item Analysis, Computation of Reliability & Validity, Writing of Research Questions & Hypothesis, Free Digital Research Report Writing and Qualitative Research Skills. The participants were given 10 choice based assignments based on the themes taken up in daywise technical sessions. An online test was administered where 54% of the participants scored above 50%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 72%, 23%, 05% & 00% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the programme was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 87% in Excellent, 13% in Very good & Nil in Good, Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory categories. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed the guests and presented the Programme report highlighting objectives, participation analysis, programme outcomes & feedback results followed by Chief Guest by Prof. Srinivasa Varakhedi (Vice Chancellor, Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University, Ramtek, Maharashtra) & Presidential address by our Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. The programme ended with a vote of thanks followed by Shanti Path. E-Certificate and e-Photo album were mailed within a week to the successful participants after the completion of the programme.
