Implementation of NEP 2020: In context of Higher Education Dated 11th February, 2022

Brief Report

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized National Webinar on Implementation of NEP 2020: In context of Higher Education dated 11th February, 2022 which is the 12th programme of Phase-V. The objectives of this webinar were to acquaint with the main features of NEP 2020 & to give insight in its implementation especially in the context of Higher Education. This online webinar was conducted through Google Meet platform and was live streamed through YouTube. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj. In addition to inaugural & valedictory, the webinar had 03 lectures on the theme viz. first Lecture- NEP 2020: An Overview by Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj (Director-TLC SLBSNS University, New Delhi), second Lecture-Implementation of NEP 2020: Higher Education by Prof. S.P. Malhotra (Ex-Head & Dean, Faculty of Education, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana) and third Lecture- Implementation of NEP 2020: Research - Prof. Arbind Jha (School of Education, IGNOU, New Delhi). The registrations received till last date was 1160. Out of 1160 participants 929 were from 26 states and 231 from 05 Union Territories. The 26 states and numbers of participants were Andhra Pradesh (20), Assam (09), Bihar (132), Chhattisgarh (08), Goa (02), Gujarat (07), Haryana (52), Himachal Pradesh (08), Jharkhand (40), Karnataka (11), Kerala (05), Madhya Pradesh (214), Maharashtra (57), Manipur (02) Meghalaya (01), Nagaland (01), Odisha (26), Punjab (07), Rajasthan (65), Sikkim (02), Tamil Nadu (36), Telangana (05), Tripura (04), Uttar Pradesh (146), Uttarakhand (44) & West Bengal (25) and from 05 UTs were Andaman & Nicobar (01), Chandigarh (04), Delhi (213), J&K (11) & Puducherry (02). In order to ensure the quality of the webinar from the participants' point of view an online feedback about Webinar was taken on 5 point scale ranging from Excellent to Unsatisfactory and the average found was 75% in Excellent, 18% in Very Good, 4% in Good, 1% in Satisfactory & 2% in Unsatisfactory categories. The valedictory session concluded with the Presidential Address by our hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Murlimanohar Pathak, SLBSNS University and ended with vote of thanks by Director of the Centre followed by Shanti Path. After the completion of the webinar, the e-Certificate was mailed to the successful participants.
