Phase-V, Programme-13 One Week Online National Faculty Development Programme on Using & Managing Online Teaching & Assessment From 07th to 11th March, 2022

Brief Report

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized One Week Online National Faculty Development Programme on Using & Managing Online Teaching & Assessment from 07th to 11th March, 2022 which is the 13th programme of Phase-V. The objectives of this programme were to familiarize with various online teaching platforms, eresource & assessment development tools, to develop skills related to creating & using online to enhance the competencies of developing integrating assessment, & various e-resources viz. image, audio, video, picture & infographics etc. with online teaching and to give insight in the process of using various Learning Management System. This programme was conducted in an online mode through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj followed by the Presidential Address Hon'ble Vice Chancellor University, of of our Prof. Murlimanohar Pathak. The programme was transacted through 30 distinctly designed sessions comprising of inaugural, induction, 14 demonstrations based technical sessions, 05 Question & Answer and 05 self-practice sessions, 01 each viz. online assessment, feedback, sharing of experiences and valedictory sessions. The registrations received for the programme were 39 and the same continued the programme successfully. Out of 39 participants, 31 were from 13 states and 8 from 02 UTs. The participants from 13 states include Andhra Pradesh (02), Assam (02), Bihar (02), Gujarat (02), Harvana (03), Madhya Pradesh (01), Maharashtra (04), Odisha (01), Rajasthan (05), Tamil Nadu (01), Telangana (01), Uttar Pradesh (03) & Uttarakhand (04) while that of two UTs were Delhi (04) & Jammu & Kashmir (04). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of 12 Resource Persons having expertise in the concerned area from various reputed institutions of the Country. The main themes covered in the programme were- Instructional Designs & Approaches for Online Teaching, Interactive Online Tools, Online Assessment Tools - Socrative, Jeopardy & e-Rubrics Use & Development of Image e-Resources, e-Course Development through Canvas, Managing Online Teaching through Google Classroom & Edmodo, Web Conferencing Tools, Creating Effective PPTs, Video Development Tools, Using & Managing Audio Resources, CC Licensing, Online Assessment through. The participants were assigned choice based 05 assignments based on the themes taken up in the technical sessions. An online test was administered where 56% of the participants scored above 50%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participant's point of view online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 75%, 21%, 03% & 01% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the programme was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 79% Excellent, 18% Very good, 03% Good, 00% Satisfactory and 00% Unsatisfactory. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed the guests and presented the Programme report highlighting objectives, participation analysis, programme outcomes & feedback results followed by Chief Guest by Prof. Santosh Panda (Director STRIDE IGNOU, New Delhi) & Presidential address by our Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. The programme ended with a vote of thanks followed by Shanti Path. E-Certificate and e-Photo album were mailed within a week to the successful participants after the completion of the programme.
