## Phase-V, Programme-02 One Day Online Workshop on Creating & Using Google Form Dated 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2021

## **Brief Report**

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized One Day Online Workshop on Creating & Using Google Forms for Students & Research Scholars of all disciplines of our university dated 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 which is the 2nd programme of Phase-V. The objectives of this workshop were to develop skills & competencies related to creating & using Google Form. This online workshop was conducted through Google Meet platform. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj followed by Presidential address of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of our University, Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey and ended with vote of thanks. In addition to inaugural & valedictory the workshop was transacted with demonstration 02 technical sessions Question & Answer and 01 each self-practice, online assessment and feedback sessions. The registrations received till last date were 125 and the same continued the programme successfully. The participants were from 12 Departments of SLBSNS University, New Delhi, which were -Education (65), Veda (06), Vyakarana (13), Dharamshastra (02), Jyotish (12), Vastushastra (05), Sahitya (12), Sankhya Yoga (02), Yoga (02), Advaita (01), Vishistadwaita (01) and Jain Darshan (04). All the technical sessions were conducted under the able guidance of 02 Resource Persons having expertise in this area. The main themes covered in the workshop were- An Introduction to Google Form and Creating Questions in the Google Form. The participants were assigned 01 assignment viz. Creating Google Forms with any 5 Questions of your choice. An online test was administered where 86% of the participants scored above 60%. In order to ensure the quality of the lectures delivered from the participants' point of view an online feedback about the Resource Persons was taken in 04 categories viz. Outstanding, Very good, Good & Satisfactory and the average found was 74%, 22%, 04% & 00% in the respective categories. In addition to this, online feedback about the workshop was also taken on 10 points in five categories and the average percentage was found to be 53% Excellent, 34% Very good, 09% Good, 04% Satisfactory and 00% Unsatisfactory. In the valedictory session, the Director of the Centre welcomed and presented the workshop outcomes followed by Presidential address of our hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey. The workshop ended with vote of thanks and Shanti Path. After the completion of the workshop, the e-Certificate and e-Photo album were mailed to the successful participants.
