## Phase-V, Programme-04 National Webinar on Implementation of NEP 2020: In context of Sanskrit Education Dated 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2021

## **Brief Report**

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University (Central University), New Delhi established under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India organized National Webinar on Implementation of NEP 2020: In context of Sanskrit Education dated 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 which is the 4th programme of Phase-V. The objectives of this webinar were to acquaint with the main features of NEP 2020 & to give insight in its implementation especially in the context of Sanskrit Education. This online webinar was conducted through Google Meet platform and was live streamed through YouTube. The inaugural session commenced with the welcome speech and backdrop note by the Director of the Centre Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj. In addition to inaugural & valedictory, the webinar had 03 lectures on the theme viz. first Lecture- NEP 2020: An Overview by Dr. Shakila T. Shamsu (Ex-OSD-NEP, Department of Higher Education, Government of Education, Govt. of India), second Lecture- Implementation of NEP 2020: Language Education by Prof. Sandhva Singh (Head, Department of Education in Languages, NCERT, New Delhi) and third Lecture- Implementation of NEP 2020: Sanskrit Education -Prof. Chandkiran Saluja (Director, Academics, Samskrit Promotion Foundation, New Delhi). The registrations received till last date was 1072. Out of 1072 participants 852 were from 25 states and 220 from 04 Union Territories. The 25 states and numbers of participants were Andhra Pradesh (30), Assam (09), Bihar (47), Chhattisgarh (25), Goa (03), Gujarat (26), Harvana (83), Himachal Pradesh (13), Jharkhand (16), Karnataka (21), Kerala (05), Madhya Pradesh (79), Maharashtra (69), Meghalaya (01), Nagaland (01), Odisha (18), Punjab (09), Rajasthan (92), Tamil Nadu (15), Telangana (09), Tripura (06), Uttar Pradesh (138), Uttarakhand (61) & West Bengal (32) and from 04 UTs were Andaman & Nicobar (03), Chandigarh (02), Delhi (203) & J&K (12). In order to ensure the quality of the webinar from the participants' point of view an online feedback about Webinar was taken on 4 point scale ranging from Excellent to Satisfactory and the average found was 79% in Excellent, 16% in Very Good and 5% in Good categories. The valedictory session concluded with the Presidential Address by our hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey, SLBSNS University and ended with vote of thanks by Director of the Centre followed by Shanti Path. After the completion of the webinar, the e-Certificate was mailed to the successful participants.
