ABOUT TLC

The Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha (Deemed to be University), New Delhi was established in the component of Centres of Excellence for Curriculum and Pedagogy under Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT) scheme of MHRD, Govt. of India. This scheme was launched with intent to improve quality of educational development at all stages of education. The vision of the established TLC is to prepare Teachers, Teacher Educators and Researchers for empowering them to address the needs for designing, implementing and evaluating teaching-learning systems in the field of Language Education especially Sanskrit and augment concerns for research based strategies in respect to language pedagogy. The centre has been identified in the list of 30 new centres (IInd phase) for conducting one month mandatory Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) by MHRD.

Backdrop

The mandatory Faculty Induction Programme has been initiated on the recommendations of the **Group of Secretaries (GoS) of Education and Social development** through all the approved centres under **Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching scheme (MHRD)** for improving the quality of higher education. This has also been **notified by the UGC wide Gazette of India No. Regd. No. DL 33004/99 dated July 18, 2018.** This one month programme has a critical role to play in promoting academic excellence and innovation in higher education. The course content of this programme includes roles & responsibilities of HE faculty, university structure, various teaching methodologies, qualitative& quantitative approaches to research, use of ICT in teaching & assessment, academic leadership, personal- emotional development, constitutional values and environmental consciousness in order to enhance personal, instructional, organizational and professional developments of the teachers. Thus, the programme aims at improving the professional capabilities and performances of teachers for delivering effective and quality learning.

Objectives

The objectives of this programme are as follows:

- to familiarise with the university structure & its functioning.
- to sensitize and motivate higher education faculty for adopting learner centred approaches.
- to give exposure to new pedagogic methods of teaching including that of ICT.
- to promote competencies related to research procedures & leadership.
- to develop insight towards constitutional values & environmental issues.

Target Group

- All newly inducted higher education faculty (within 04 years of joining) working as Assistant Professor/Lecturer (Permanent or Ad-hoc) in UGC approved colleges/ universities/ higher education institutions (both Government & Private) from all disciplines.
- Participants will be selected on first-come, first-served basis.
- Preference will be given to permanent faculties and those from Govt. institutions.

Registration

There will be no registration fee for this programme. The intake capacity of this FIP is 40. The interested participants fulfilling the above mentioned criteria may send their duly filled *registration form* by downloading it from www.slbsrsv.ac.in and sending by mail to *tlcfip@slbsrsv.ac.in*. Please confirm your participation latest by 16th July, 2019 (Tuesday). The submission of original filled registration form is mandatory at the time of joining the programme.

Accommodation will be provided on sharing basis to outstation participants from the evening of 23rd July, 2019 to the morning of 23rd August, 2019 and Travel allowances by shortest route (3rd AC railway fare/actual bus fare) will be reimbursed to the outstation participants (Max.-Rs.5000) and subject to the production of proof.
