About TLC

Backdrop

In order to make meaningful use of the information and educational reality relative to it, practitioners and professionals have to be introduced to the specific methodologies of research which are being put in plates. One of the important areas in this regard is concerned with the improvement of quality of teaching and learning for which focus on new research paradigm connected directly to pedagogy is called for. The present workshop has been organized to orient teacher educators and teachers associated with language pedagogy to the emerging new issues and paradigmatic shifts in research to understand, apply, explain and interpret them in a meaningful perspective. It is intended that the various sessions slated during the workshop will help in enriching and enhancing competencies for taking-up researches in the area of language pedagogy.

Objectives

The workshop has the following objectives:

- to reorient the participants with the basic steps and processes followed under quantitative and qualitative research approaches.
- to help develop competencies in formulating research problems, research questions and research hypotheses.
- to get acquainted with the style of writing review of related literature.
- to develop competencies for choosing appropriate sampling procedure.
- Enabling the participants to choose appropriate statistical procedure for analyzing quantitative data.
- to promote the competencies of writing and reporting research work in various formats viz synopsis, abstract, research paper, research proposal and thesis.
- to differentiate between the reporting procedures of qualitative and quantitative research paradigms.

Target Group:

The Participants considered for this workshop will be-

- Teacher Educators of Sanskrit Universities.
- Teacher Educators of colleges or universities associated with language teaching viz Sanskrit, Hindi and English.
