- to identify the various assessment exercises suitable for various types of lessons in Sanskrit Teaching.
- to prepare the format for Pupil teachers handbook by incorporating all the discussed components.

#### For whom it is intended

The target group of this workshop will be Sanskrit teachers and Teacher educators related to teaching of Sanskrit. In line with the nature of the workshop, the Resource Persons cum Participants will be invited on the basis of their expertise in content development and Sanskrit pedagogy.

#### Implementation mode

The various sessions of the workshop will focus on developing a suitable format for pupil teacher handbook for teaching Sanskrit at upper primary level through group discussions followed by presentations under the supervision of Experts.
