Brief Report of Prog.-05 10 Days National Workshop on Techno-Pedagogical Skills for Teachers Date – From 27th Nov. to 07th Dec., 2018

A 10 days National Workshop on Techno-Pedagogical Skills for Teachers was organised by Teaching Learning Centre (TLC) of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, New Delhi from 27th Nov. to 07th Dec., 2018 with an intent to empower the teacher educators with competencies related to intelligent use and integration of techno-pedagogical skills in their pedagogical processes. The workshop was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Prof. Nageshwar Rao (Vice Chancellor, IGNOU, New Delhi) in the august presence of Chancellor Dr. Hari Gautam, Vice Chancellor Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey and Registrar Dr. Alka Rai of Vidyapeetha. The welcome speech and backdrop of the workshop was delivered by the Project Head Prof. Amita Pandey Bhardwaj. The workshop had 40 sessions (04 sessions/day) including inaugural, induction, technical, sharing of experiences, cultural programme, assessment, feedback and valedictory sessions. All the technical sessions of the workshop were designed on the practice centric approach. The objectives of the workshop were to familiarize the participants with technology supported tools, devices & procedures and to develop competencies for using techno-pedagogical skills. The total participants registered in this workshop were 37 out of which 17 could not join due to some unavoidable reasons and 20 continued the workshop. The various sessions of the workshop were conducted under the guidance of highly experienced eleven Resource Persons from various reputed universities of the country. The main themes covered in the technical sessions were how to use Google forms, ways for using blended learning and flipped classrooms, creating and using various types of eresources such as OERs, Presentation tube, Screen castify, Slide N tell, Video notes, Video shows, DU recorder & SWAYAM, to use various Presentation softwares such as Presentation tube, Slide share, Google slide, Prezi, Coggle, Google classroom, Edmodo and Moodle, how to edit audios and videos by using Audacity and Open shot softwares respectively. Each topic taken-up in the technical session was followed by hands-on-practice sessions and the assignments done by the participants were submitted online. The feedback about the lectures delivered by the Resource Persons was taken from the participants in 03 categories viz. excellent, good and satisfactory and the average percentage was found to be 57%, 34% and 09% in respective categories. In addition to this, feedback about the workshop was also taken from the participants on 10 points in five categories viz. excellent, very good, good, satisfactory and unsatisfactory and average percentage was found to be 80%, 20%, 0%, 0% and 0% in five categories respectively. An online assessment of the participants was also conducted where the performance of most of the Participants was above 60%. In the valedictory session the Project Head welcomed the guests and presented the workshop report followed by the sharing of experiences by the participants, Chief Guest address by Prof. Santosh Panda (Ex- Chairman, NCTE, New Delhi) and presidential address by Vice Chancellor of Vidyapeetha Prof. Ramesh Kumar Pandey. The workshop ended up with certificate distribution to the participants by the guests.
